STIPULATIONS: These events are free and are open to everyone; they take place regardless of weather conditions.

REGISTRATION: All walkers personally register at the start and begin the walk.

PROCEDURE: Arrive between the start times and register on a start sheet. We provide detailed walk instructions, a map, and a start number. Participants walk at their own pace, normally taking 1 hour for 3 miles (5 kilometers) and 2-2.5 hours for 6 miles (10 kilometers). The walk returns to the start and the completion time, if any, is stated. Please check in at the finish when you return so we know you have completed the event.

PARTICIPATION: This is a fun event for all persons. People of all ages are welcome to participate though an adult must accompany minors.

FOOD and WATER: Water and hard candy are available at the start and any checkpoints. For your safety carry your own drinking water.

SANCTIONED: This event is sanctioned by AVA - America's Walking Club (ava.org), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV).

DESCRIPTION: The walk start point is the AMTRAK station at 148 W. Morse Boulevard. The 5K walk starts at the train station and walks thru downtown and Rollins College areas. The 10K walk goes thru residential streets, passes Lakes Mizell, Virginia, & Maitland on shaded, oak lined streets, visits the Rollins College campus before you see Winter Park's downtown fine shops and the excellent restaurants along Park Ave. A must stop is the Morse Museum's display of Tiffany glass art. The walk is suitable for strollers and wheelchairs but some streets are brick with no sidewalks. Pets are allowed (not inside Central Park). Please carry water. Trail Ratings: 1A. Turn left on New York Ave. Turn right on Morse Ave. and right into parking. From east SR417N at exit 38 turn left for 6.2mi or from SR436N turn left for 3.1mi on Aloma Ave. Turn right on New York. Turn right on Morse Ave. and right into parking.
