  - Per recommendation from Ron Barna, POC for Altamonte Springs, BOD agreed to change the walk to 5k route still inside the mall but then 5k outside in surrounding Altamonte area.
     Ron and Rosemary will work on the re-route and get that information back to Jenny Thomas for the renewal.

#### MFM TE Discussion

- After much input it was decided to change from Free walkers and Credit walkers to everyone paying \$3.00 per walk for both YREs and Traditional Events. Club members may purchase Frequent Walker YRE discount packages at \$2.00 per walk.
  - Change will be announced in the next MFM Newsletter and will become effective September 1, 2018.
- Thought process is this will be easy for people to understand and will benefit the club and AVA.
- No other changes will be made to the current TE walk process.
