## MID-FLORIDA MILERS WALKING CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS' MEETING January 5, 2019

#### CALL TO ORDER

The MFM Board meeting was held at Rosemary Barna's house following our Winter Park YRE walk. A quorum was present: Rosemary Barna, President, Joan Lanpher, Vice President, Sharon Axelrod, Secretary and Sharon Predham, Treasurer. Also present Mike Lanpher, MFM Trailmaster. President Rosemary Barna called the meeting to order at 12:40 pm.

#### **MINUTES**

Minutes from the September 29, 2018 board meeting, were approved and accepted.

#### TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer Sharon Predham provided:

Volunteer discussion was held concerning the Volunteer Committees that are part of the Mid-Florida Milers Bylaws. (*Italics indicate filled by other than board officers*): Publicity Committee, Routes and Trails Committee, Membership Committee, Year Round Event (YRE) Route Monitors, Newsletter Publisher, Web Master, Volunteer Coordinator. The following Committees are currently inactive: Operations Committee, Registration and Finish Volunteer Committee, Special Activities

Committee, Awards Committee, Social/Food Services Committee, and Club Historian. Mike Lanpher noted that the Board should review these and revise the Bylaws if necessary. Example: since we do not do Awards anymore that Committee should be deleted from the bylaws.

#### **PUBLICITY**

Publicity coordinator, Letty Zook, reported no changes or news for publicity.

#### TRAILMASTER'S REPORT

- Mike Lanpher asked Sharon Predham to check Appendix B of the AVA Policy Manual for any new fees or changes to fees.
- Mike provided the listing of the 2019 Walks. Some changes were identified so Mike will update and then provide the listing to the Board of Directors and Committees.
- Next pre-walk: Apopka on Saturday, January 12.
- Further Discussion:
  - Rosemary suggested handing out Fortune Cookies at the February 2 walk in The Villages since February 5 is the Chinese New Year. Joan Lanpher will purchase.
  - March 30th at Wetlands in Christmas. Mike has reserved the pavilion.
     We will have a picnic lunch of Soups and Salads. Sharon A. will create a Sign Up sheet for attendance and offerings. Offerings will need to be specific to avoid duplicates and to ensure something for everyone (gluten free, vegetarian, vegan).
  - AVA Big Give will be from March 28 through May 31. We will have poster/information at our walks.
  - Guided walks were discussed: would ensure new walkers are taken care of; could shorten the registration time, maybe stamp at registration. Apopka 19 walk registration will be 9 to 9:30 so we will see how it works.
  - Night Christmas light walks were discussed. Rosemary suggested a registration time of 5:00 to 5:30 when it is still somewhat light out and doing only a 5K. Maybe have two groups: faster and slower.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- Bench donated to a local park from the club: Rosemary will be checking with Orlando City Hall for information about Lake Eola Park.
- Web Master, Dan Barnett, had contacted the BOD concerning the renewal of Go Daddy our URL provider. The Board did approve the renewal.
- NEC/AVA had recommended a change to its accounting from 7/1—6/30 to calendar year. We have not heard anything further.

- ACE (AVA Community Events) are intended to give clubs flexibility to create
  events that are not burdened by IVV guideline with the intent of providing
  more community outreach.
  - All events are optional. Mike Lanpher provided the Board with general AVA guidelines and the rules and requirements for each of the event types.
  - Mike Kirchner has indicated an interest in creating one of these events.
     Rosemary will email the documentation to Mike K. and arrange for a time when Mike will be available to meet with the BOD and the Trailmaster.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- AVA Convention is June 9 June 16 in Albany, NY.
  - Sharon Predham will be the MFM convention delegate.
  - Rosemary will check with SERD John McClellan to find out if he will have a SERD Brochure Table and what brochures we should provide from MFM.
  - Ron Barna will create a Florida themed plaque or box for the convention Silent Auction. Rosemary will find out when is the AVA deadline.
- MFM Annual Meeting scheduled for April 13
  - We will have breakfast and then a walk, similar to what we did last year.
  - Joan Lanpher will check with Another Broken Egg.
- GroupWorks is a new AVA club communication tool
  - On-line Management tool particularly for non-profit organizations.
  - AVA is providing webinars to educate members on the facets of the tool. There is much that the tool provides.
  - Many questions: What would it help us with? Who would manage it?
     How to disseminate information to our members?
  - BOD will familiarize themselves with the site and then we will have a meeting specifically to discuss this topic
